A draft proposal was submitted in July, followed by discussions via teleconference with our BBF Agreement Managers. As a result of these discussions, PCCM submitted a final proposal on 30th August.

On 6th October, PCCM Committee received a response from Department of Education and Training (DET) with the decision not to accept the Proposal.

Since then, Sue Kingwill, Contact Inc., and PCCM Committee have invested a great deal of time and effort into preparing a counter response, requesting that the decision be reviewed.

In addition, lobby letters have been sent to fourteen Federal Ministers and MPs. Lobbying continues with the next round of letters being prepared for State Government Ministers, Local Government (Shires) and State ICPA Early Childhood Education delegates (NSW and QLD).
